When is my AGRE membership renewal due?

We normally solicit AGRE membership renewals in the summer so you may be wondering why you have not yet been encouraged to send dues. AGRE memberships were originally due in summer because of the timing for the first elections; only members can vote. However, this came at an awkward time in the fiscal year for some members and at a time when people often travel. Earlier this year, the AGRE Board of Directors decided to shift membership to a calendar year basis, to match AGRE's fiscal year. Memberships will now run from January 1 through December 31 of a single year. All current memberships will run through the end of 2017, including those renewed in the summer of 2016. We will solicit renewals in the fall of 2017 for AGRE membership in 2018. The price will remain the same: \$200 for an institutional membership, allowing two people to vote and \$100 for an individual membership, allowing one person to vote.

Some members needed an EIN number for AGRE when we first solicited memberships. Due to a mix-up at the IRS, our EIN number has recently been changed. If you need the new EIN number, please contact feagin@uw.edu.
